The revised schedule of Admission to Under Graduate(UG)/Integrated (IG) courses of Assam University (on campus) and revised eligibility criteria and merit calculation principles for 2024-25 session for first round open category (with CUET score) admission are hereby notified for information of all concerned. The admission to UG/IG courses of Assam University (on campus) will be through the University online portal https://www.ausexamination.ac.in/admission
Candidates may apply online for the course(s) on payment of Rs. 1000/- (for General and OBC students), Rs. 900/- (for OBC Non-Creamy Layer/ EWS Category) and Rs. 800/- (for SC/ST/PWD students) through payment gateway system. Eligible applicant may apply for maximum two courses. However, separate application is required to be submitted for each course. Intending candidates are advised to follow the university website for latest notification related to admission 2024-2025. Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EWS will be made as per GOI rules.
