BBA ADMISSION NOTICE

Interested applicants with CUET score may apply for Admission to Integrated MBA (BBA+MBA) Course of Assam University (on campus) for the year 2026 has been opened as per the details below:

Online applications are invited from the interested students through the University online admission portal <https://www.ausexamination.ac.in/admission>. Candidates may apply online for the course on payment of Rs. 1000/- (for General and OBC students), Rs. 900/- (for OBC Non-Creamy Layer/ EWS Category) and Rs. 800/- (for SC/ST/PWD students) through payment gateway system. Intending candidates are advised to follow the university website for latest notification related to admission 2026-2027. Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EWS will be made as per GOI rules.

The minimum cutoff mark for BBA applicants under the CUET category for admission to the Integrated MBA Program 2026 will be the 50 percentile in the CUET UG Category, in addition to the similar academic qualifying criteria as set for the NON CUET Category (relaxation for reserved category candidates will be as per GOI norms). Based on the availability of a sufficient number of applicants, the available number of seats (12) will be filled as per the seat matrix.

In case of unavailability of a sufficient number of applicants, the vacant seats under the CUET Category will be converted to the non-CUET category, and will be filled up through spot admission following Non-CUET criteria. Applicants who have already appeared in the 1st drive of the Non-CUET admission process and were found to be disqualified will not be eligible to apply again.

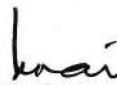
LIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND MERIT CALCULATION PRINCIPLES:

1. Qualified in class 12 (Higher Secondary) in any discipline (Science, Arts or Commerce etc) with at-least 60%, marks or equivalent CGPA (55% marks or equivalent CGPA in case of candidates belonging to reserved Category).
2. The applicant should have passed Class 12 (Higher Secondary) as mentioned above with anyone of the subjects such as Mathematics/ Accountancy / Business statistics/ Business Economics / Economics/ Statistics/ Physics/ Computer Science as one of the papers opted in Higher Secondary (class 12) Course.
3. The final Selection from amongst the eligible Candidates will be based on composite scores of candidates in
 - i. Academic records in HSLC [30% weight].
 - ii. Academic records in HS [30% weight].
 - iii. PI Scores [40% weight].
